YOUTH SERVICES GOLF BALL DROP RULES

Youth Services' Helicopter Ball Drop is presented for the benefit of raising funds to provide transformative prevention, intervention and development programs for young people and families in Windham County communities. Youth Services is a non-profit corporation under section 501 (C)3 of the Internal Revenue Code (the Presenter).

Entry fee is \$100 (per golf ball). Each participant will be entered into the Youth Services Golf Ball Drop to take place on Wednesday, Wednesday, July 28, 2021 at approx. 6 p.m. at the Brattleboro Country Club. the numbered golf balls will be placed randomly in a bucket, flown in a helicopter and dropped above the 9th fairway at the Brattleboro Country Club. In any event, the Golf Ball Drop will be spectacular, a "MUST SEE FREE EVENT".

After purchase, participant will be assigned numbered golf ball(s) based on their entry. A minimum of 50 golf balls must be sold for the event of the golf ball drop to occur. Balls are sold on a first-come, first-serve basis up to 100. Any inadvertently sold beyond the cap of 100 will be refunded.

The participant whose golf ball lands the closest to the PIN will receive the cash prize of \$3000.

Eligibility of purchaser, and anyone to whom a purchaser legally transfers a ball must be 21 years of age or older at time of purchase/transfer. Purchasers may enter more than once and need not be a resident of the state of Vermont. Only one (1) individual may be identified as an entry owner.

To participate in the Youth Services' Helicopter Golf Ball Drop event, entry ticket(s) may be purchased in one of the following ways: 1.) Directly from a Youth Services representative who has been given permission by the Golf Ball Drop committee to sell tickets. 2.) By Internet at www.youthservicesinc.org/ball-drop. 3.) By phone calling 802-257-0361. 4.) By U.S. mail at Youth Services, 32 Walnut St., PO Box 6008, Brattleboro VT, 05302-6008. Method of payment is by cash, check, credit card or Click & Pledge. Each entry requires name, address, phone number and/or e-mail address. Golf Ball Drop purchases are non-refundable.

A chart will be posted on the website youthservicesinc.org/ball-drop listing entries and golf ball numbers, updated each week. Odds of winning are based on the number of entries sold but you will have a one in 100 chance of winning, if not better. The prize will be awarded to the purchaser of record. All balls entered will be provided by the Brattleboro Country Club and shall remain their property.

By entering the Youth Services helicopter golf ball drop, winner consents to the use of their name, voice and photograph and/or trade purposes, except where prohibited by law. All federal, state, local laws and regulations apply. Void where prohibited by law.

The 1st place winner will be announced at the site of the 36th Annual Youth Services Golf Tournament and need not be present to win. The winner will be notified via phone and/or email in the event the winner is not present at the Annual Golf Tournament. Winner will be posted on www.youthservicesinc.org/ball-drop within the week following event. If 1st place prize winner does not claim his or her prize from the Presenter within 90 days of the golf ball drop that prize will go into the Youth Services Endowment Fund.

By participating, each participant releases, discharges, indemnifies, and holds harmless Youth Services, the Brattleboro Country Club, and Renaud Bros., Inc., the helicopter crew, their parents, subsidiary, successor and affiliated companies/organizations, and their respective officers, directors, employees, agents and representatives, advertising agencies and promotional partners (collectively the "Releases") from any and all liability, loss, harm, injury, damage, cost and expense whatsoever arising directly or indirectly from the use of the first prize or participation in the raffle.

All federal, state, and local taxes are the sole responsibility of the individual winner.

If for any reason beyond the control of the Presenter such as weather conditions, the Presenter determines not to conduct the Golf Ball Drop on Wednesday, July 28, 2021, the Presenter reserves the right to re-schedule the Golf Ball Drop within one week.
